The migrant workers live in sub-human conditions in the slums in and around Bangalore. Many of these people work in the construction industry, building posh flats and houses. It's an irony that the affluent are oblivious, of the living and working conditions. Migrant families often live in unsafe, temporary housing, such as "blue tents" with no access to running water, electricity, or sanitation. Migrant communities are vulnerable to evictions due to the illegal and informal nature of their settlements.

The migrants come from various parts of the country for the labour purpose and they will not have any eagerness about their children's education and wellbeing and they eventually become school dropout.
